Purpose of Job:

To provide invaluable support to the Pre-School team, guided by the Pre-School Manager, ensuring the delivery of safe, nurturing, and high-quality education and care for younger children.

Main Duties:

- 1. Supervise children in both indoor and outdoor environments.
- 2. Assist with lunchtime activities, including setup and cleanup.
- 3. Support key persons in educational activities and maintain effective communication with parents/carers.
- 4. Promptly report any concerns regarding children, parents, or equipment safety to the Pre-School Manager, while maintaining confidentiality.
- 5. Provide teaching and appropriate levels of support and stimulation to children.
- 6. Attend staff meetings to contribute to the team's collaborative efforts.
- 7. Participate in in-service training courses and meetings as required.
- 8. Uphold confidentiality as per pre-school policies and procedures.
- 9. Fulfill other reasonable duties as directed by the Pre-School Manager in alignment with the pre-school's objectives.
